

Notice to Revs & T&O League Bowlers,

This communication is to inform you that league bowling has been postponed until at least April 1st. We will work with each league's officers to determine the appropriate steps for the remainder of the league season. Current government requirements are to operate at 50 percent of seating capacity or 50 total people, whichever is less and preserve social distancing of 6 feet between tables, booths, bar stools, and order counters (waiting for clarification on bowling lanes however I feel that they will be regulated in the same grouping, as they are looked at as an ordering counter or table). The White House briefing yesterday has also recommended putting the number of people to 10 and requirements have been changing rapidly. Almost all leagues are over the 50 person limit, along with the ability for our bowlers to be carriers and transmitters of the aggressive COVID-19 virus, it is in the best interest of our guests, staff, and communities to postpone and abide by recommendations of our government. At this time, T&O Lanes will remain closed until leagues can resume. Revs will be focusing on food delivery and take-out so please watch our website bowlrevs.com for details.

As you know, we are in the home stretch of our main bowling season. I, like many of you, have been looking forward to seeing spring come and enjoy some time outdoors. It's a scary reality as to the future of not only our business but business in general as the impacts of this virus continue to evolve. I feel for our staff who rely on serving you for your generosity in tips each week and for them I am truly heartbroken. I feel for our guests, who looked forward to coming to league each week as a place to socially bond and enjoy the camaraderie of each other. I feel for our bowling pro shops and distributors who rely on bowling league to make their wages. I feel for the product makers who rely on the distributors to purchase and sell their products. All will be significantly impacted. As much as I wish there was positive financial news to report, this is a scary time for businesses and employees, Revs & T&O included. I am hopeful that we can make decisions with league officers to fulfill the remaining weeks of the bowling schedule to allow our staff the opportunity to be picked back up and create enough cash flow to make it through the summer months. Our community has been so receptive to Revs & T&O and I am extremely grateful for that. Success comes by means of data saying none of our league bowlers, guests, or team members have been impacted by the COVID-19 virus and businesses all over, with its team members, will be able to open back and return to normal.
